Trustees Annual Report for the year ended 30th November 2014.

The Charity is administered by an Executive Committee who are its Trustees. The objects of the Trust are in Clause C of the Constitution adopted on 18th October 2004 and are summarised as conservation, stimulation of interest and education for the benefit of the public in and around Cowbridge.

The Trust was registered by the Charity Commission on 10th December 2004.

We ensure that the work of the Trust, its Trustees and its volunteers is for public benefit and within the objects in the Constitution.

Restricted Funds are created for specific purposes where money has been granted for those purposes or where we undertake work at cost to the Trust.

In this accounting year Trust funds were allocated and we received a gift to help fund the "Renovation of the Bridge Plaque" project, a total of £550, in both cases on the basis that the amounts will fall into the Trust's general funds if not needed for the project.

The Trustees consider that the general cash balance is needed for the efficient running of the Trust's projects.

The Old Hall Gardens are open to the public and we continue our work to support them with planting and garden maintenance, and have installed additional benches. Members of the public and local organisations have made good use of the Gardens and the Reading Circle during the year. The Circle is used by both children and adults.

We have provided bilingual information boards in the Gardens, and booklets about the Gardens for local schools. We are grateful for grants from local authority and other providers.

As mentioned last year, The Trust is negotiating an extension to the formal agreement with the Vale of Glamorgan Council, the owner of the Old Hall and grounds, to enable us to continue our improvements to the area. We have also applied for a license and funding to enable us to continue maintenance of the Towns Walls. A decision is expected shortly.
